Age will be determined as of Jan 1st

Appropriate Attire is required for all Classes including Long Pants and Heeled Boots, See Rules.

Must be saddled and bridled appropriately for all classes

All patterns will be posted. **HELMETS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED**

Novice Rider classes are open to anyone who has not won 3 first place ribbons in that particular division in which they are showing – i.e.
English/Western

Western classes – Two hands allowed with a snaffle bit or bosal on any age horse.

To qualify for PTR year end awards, you must be a current and paid PTR member and have completed the required eight (8) volunteer hours
at designated events. Four (4) hours must be completed by August 1, 2007. & attend at least 1 membership meeting prior to November 1,
2007. You can sign up for volunteer

hours through the Show Office or by calling a Pleasure Show Committee Member.
