Classes may be combined at the discretion of the Show Judge - Points will be tallied according to original age group.

Showmanship and Trail classes can be shown in English AND/OR Western tack.

Age is determined as of January 1 of each year.

Appropriate Attire is required for all classes including long pants and heeled boots.

All patterns will be posted at the shows. Helmets are strongly encouraged.

Novice Rider classes are open to anyone who has not won 3 first place ribbons in that particular discipline.

The PTR Operations Manual provides full rules and descriptions for Pleasure Shows. Riders are responsible for receiving and understanding requirements. Copies are available on website.
